To High School Art Teachers,

We invite you and your students to participate in Katonah Museum of Art's **Young Artists 2023: High School Art Exhibition**. The exhibition will be on view February 5 – February 26, 2023. We are celebrating our 40th anniversary this year, so please stay tuned for special activities that may be added to this year's program. In this packet you will find all the information needed for your school to participate. If you are new to the program or have any questions, we are happy to discuss at your convenience, just reach out to: **madasko@katonahmuseum.org.**

Young Artists gives high school students the opportunity to participate behind-the-scenes in many aspects of mounting a museum exhibition. The first component of this program is the *Graphic Design Workshop* in which students design the *Young Artists 2023* invitation. This year, the workshop will have both in-person and virtual components. The virtual workshop will take place Wednesday, November 9, 2022. Led graphic design educators from Fox Lane HS, this presentation will introduce important graphic design concepts and outline the objectives of the postcard invitation design. Students will then attend an all-day, in-person design workshop on Monday, November 21 at the KMA, where they will complete their projects. The winning design will be selected from these submissions. Teachers should submit the names and emails of one or two seniors to participate in this workshop by Thursday, November 3. Email the enclosed confirmation form to <a href="mailto:ma

In January and February, senior students' artwork is selected by teachers, framed, and delivered to the KMA for the exhibition. After the artwork is received, select students from each school participate in curating and installing the exhibition on two **Installation Days**, held at the KMA on February 1 and February 2. Artists, teachers, families, and friends are invited to the exhibition opening taking place on Sunday, February 5, 2023. All guests will be required to register in advance. A link will be sent in the weeks leading up to the event. The *Young Artists 2022* exhibition will be open to the public through February 26.

To participate in *Young Artists 2023*, your school must pay the annual fee of \$350 for the KMA School Program. Please let us know if you would like an invoice sent to you. The KMA School Program also allows for unlimited virtual or in-person tours of KMA exhibitions. This year's exhibitions include *Tenacity & Resilience: The Art of Jerry Pinkney* (October 9, 2022 – January 22, 2023) and *Miniature Worlds: Joseph Cornell, Ray Johnson, and Yayoi Kusama* (March 12 – June 25, 2023).

YOUNG ARTISTS 2023 - Program Details Exhibition Dates: February 5 – February 26, 2023

GRAPHIC DESIGN WORKSHOP:

Teacher selects two seniors to participate in this workshop and send student names and emails by **Thursday**, **November 3**. Details will be sent to workshop participants by email.*

- Wednesday, November 9, 7:00-8:00 Virtual Graphic Design Presentation. Graphic Design Educators lead a
 virtual presentation, which will introduce important graphic design concepts and outline the objectives of
 the postcard invitation design.
- Monday, November 21, 9-2:30, In-person Graphic Design Workshop. Students attend an all-day design workshop at the KMA.
 - Students will prepare 3 design concepts to bring to the workshop
 - Students will have all day to complete 1 design and submit it to the contest.
- Designs will be voted on by participating students, KMA staff, Board, and volunteers to select a winning design to be used as the postcard invitation for *Young Artists 2023*.

• Week of December 6:

 Paperwork for the exhibition, including consignment forms and labels, will be sent out to teachers by email (or mail, if requested.) The label information must be returned by Monday, January 23.

DELIVERY OF ARTWORK to KMA: Monday, January 30 and Tuesday, January 31, 1:00 - 5:00 pm (or by appointment)

- Teachers deliver 10 artworks one piece of art per senior. Sculpture, ceramics, mixed media, and video or media presentations are welcome.
- o Art MUST BE framed, labeled, and <u>ready to hang</u> with all correct paperwork.

EXHIBITION INSTALLATION: Wednesday, February 1 and Thursday, February 2

- o Each school may choose up to four seniors or juniors to attend an installation time slot at KMA.
- Students will be introduced to exhibition design concepts in advance through a pre-recorded video.
- Hands-on installation of the exhibition artworks with guidance from professional installation staff will happen at KMA.

• OPENING: Sunday, February 5

 Artists, teachers, families and friends are invited to the opening celebration. All guests must register in advance.

- The Museum is free to all visitors throughout the exhibition. Guests are encouraged to reserve tickets in advance.
