Perrotin Perrotin is thrilled to announce Ali Banisadr: The Alchemist, the artist's first major U.S. museum survey at the The Katonah Museum of Art (@katonahmuseum).

This exhibition encompasses nearly twenty years of the Brooklyn-based, Iranian-born artist's singular practice, from 2006 to the present, across the mediums of painting, drawing, and printmaking. Sculpture, a new direction for the artist, will be presented for the first time.

The exhibition will be accompanied by a catalogue with critical essays by Dr. Grażyna Subelytė, Associate Curator, Peggy Guggenheim Collection; Dr. Bill Sherman, Director, The Warburg Institute, University of London; and Michelle Yun Mapplethorpe, Executive Director, Katonah Museum of Art. It will also feature a transcribed conversation with the artist and noted art historian Robert Storr, and a fully illustrated plate section.
